1989 - 2019

## Year   Milestone

- 1989** . Tsilhqot'in Tribal Council Incorporated
  - . (August) Assertion of the Nemiah (Xeni Gwet'in) Declaration
- 1990** . (April) Trapline Action registered in BC Courts by Roger William in response to proposed logging
- 1992** . (May) Roadblock at Henry's Crossing to stop proposed logging in the Brittany Tringle by Carrier Lumber
- 1995** . Name change to Tsilhqot'in National Government
- 1998** . (December) Brittany Triangle Action registered in BC courts by Roger William in response to proposed logging
- 1999** . Tsilhqot'in Traditional Use Study commences
- 2001** . Conclusion of Tsilhqot'in Traditional Use Study
  - . TNG Turns 10
- 2002** . (November) Court Case begins for Title & Rights at the BC Supreme Court
- 2003** . (December) Registry of the Charleyboy Writ with the Supreme Court of BC
- 2006** . TNG Stewardship Planning Portal - begins development
  - . TNG Ranger program first explored
- 2007** . (April) Victory at Supreme Court of BC, recognized Tsilhqot'in Rights (Vickers Decision)
  - . TNG Stewardship Planning Portal I comes online
- 2008** . TNG Initiates work on South Chilcotin Integrated Resource Plan
- 2009** . Signing of the Tsilhqot'in Framework Agreement (now Tsilhqot'in Stewardship Agreement) with British Columbia
  - . TNG Turns 20
- 2010** . Formation of Tsilhqot'in Health Hub
  - . TNG establishes inland commercial fishery
  - . (April) BCTS, West Fraser and Tolko agree to work with TNG on South Chilcotin Integrated Resource Plan
  - . (November) Victory at Težtan Biny - Canada rejects Prosperity Mine
  - . Appeal for Tsilhqot'in Title held at BC Court of Appeal
- 2011** . TNG Stewardship Planning Portal II comes online
- 2012** . (June) BC Court of Appeal upholds Vickers Decision
- 2013** . (January) Supreme Court of Canada will hear Tsilhqot'in Title case
  - . (November) Tsilhqot'in Leadership and Elders delegation travel to Ottawa
  - . South Chilcotin Integrated Resource Plan in effect
- 2014** . (February) Victory at Težtan Biny - Canada rejects New Prosperity Mine
  - . (June) Victory: The Supreme Court of Canada recognizes unextinguished Aboriginal Title to a portion of the claim area; states that more likely exists beyond.
  - . (September) Letter of Understanding signed between Tsilhqot'in Nation & British Columbia
  - . (October) Totem Pole gifted by Tim Paul of Nuučaanuḥ?ath Nation (Nuu-chah-nulth) to Tsilhqot'in Nation coincides with announcement of the Nexwagwezʔan (Dasiqox Tribal Park)
  - . (October) BC Premier formally acknowledges the wrongful trial & hanging of six Tsilhqot'in Nits'ilʔin in 1864 - provincial exoneration.
- 2015** . First Annual All-Nations Spring Classic Walk/Run in Tl'esqox
  - . (September) Sto:lo Honouring of Tsilhqot'in Chiefs
  - . (September) Letter of Intent signed between Tsilhqot'in Nation & British Columbia
  - . TNG wins Award of Merit in Sustainable Forestry from ABFP for the South Chilcotin Integrated Resource Plan
  - . Ongoing negotiations with British Columbia
- 2016** . (February) Signing of historic Nenqay Deni Accord between Tsilhqot'in Nation & British Columbia
  - . (June) Memorandum of Understanding signed between Tsilhqot'in Nation & Homalco Nation
  - . Establishment of a Tsilhqot'in Title Ranger program
- 2017** . (May) Memorandum of Understanding signed between Tsilhqot'in Nation & Southern Dākelh Nation Alliance
  - . (July) Interim Governance Agreement on Fisheries Management signed between the Tsilhqot'in Nation & Canada
  - . (July) Unprecedented destruction from wildfire: bolsters Tsilhqot'in unity
  - . (October) Tsilhqot'in Radio hits the airwaves
- 2018** . (March) Government of Canada formally exonerates Tsilhqot'in Chiefs wrongfully hung in 1864 in announcement by Prime Minister Trudeau in the House of Commons in Ottawa.
  - . (April) Tripartite Collaborative Emergency Management Agreement signed between the Tsilhqot'in Nation, British Columbia, and Canada.
  - . (June) Tsilhqot'in Chejaghetadelh - first Unity Gathering on governance at ʔEsdilagh
  - . (November) Prime Minister Trudeau delivers the message of exoneration to Tsilhqot'in members on Title Land
  - . (July) Establishment of the Tsilhqot'in Moose Protection Law
  - . (November) Gwets'en Nilt'i Pathways Letter signed by the Prime Minister while on Title Lands, committing the Government of Canada to reach a Transformative Change Agreement and to immediately improve housing for Tsilhqot'in people.
  - . Tsilhqot'in Solar Farm begins construction
- 2019** . (January) Letter of Understanding, outlining a unifying approach to working together on shared territory discussions, signed by the Tsilhqot'in Nation and the Southern Dākelh Nation Alliance.
  - . (April) Release of Nagwedižk'an Gwaneš Gangu Ch'inidžed Ganexwilagh "The Fire Awakened Us" report on the 2017 wildfire season is released.
  - . Completion of Tsilhqot'in Solar Farm
  - . TNG turns 30
