16 pieces heavy equipment3 intermediate helicopters supporting58 ground personnel

Chilcotin River Side

- Heavy equipment continues building a fuel break on the Chilcotin River FSR
- Containment on NW corner remains a priority

Chilko River N

• Ground crews continue with mop-up along the E and W flanks

Chilko River S

- 100% guarded on S flank
- Patrolling continues on this area of the fire
